Middle School Board Rezoning Possibility-

At the November 14, 2016 School Board meeting, the administration indicated that a proposed calendar could be provided at the December Board meeting in the event the Board wanted to further discuss adjusting attendance zones at the middle school level. Below is the calendar of proposed timelines for discussing the issue.

Monday, January 9,2017- Initial presentation by staff of attendance zone options

Week of Jan. 23'd -27th, 2017- Community meeting(s) Monday, January 30, 2017- Public hearing and work session

Monday, February 13, 2017- Public hearing, work session and request for final action
